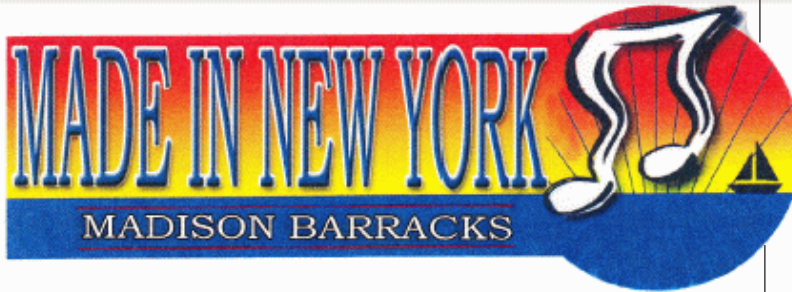

Saturday July 2nd from 11:00 am to 9:00 pm

The Society for the Preservation of Madison Barracks is proud to introduce a 2011 summer festival called “Made in New York”. The event is planned to merge two of the previous Sackets Harbor events, The 1812 Beer & Wine Show and the Chamber’s Taste of New York event concepts into one and to expand on the theme to showcase products and services made in New York. This will include locally grown produce, farm products, grass fed beef and free range poultry farmers, as well as organic fruit and vegetables, arts, crafts, wines and crafted beers.

The one day event is designed as a significant fund raiser with the principal recipient being Meals on Wheels of Greater Watertown. As the grand finale of the day’s event, the show will feature a three band lineup, with the 15th year reunion concert of Watertown’s own Wirlwind starting at 4:00pm, followed by Blue Coupe, featuring the Bouchard Brothers of Clayton, the founding members of Blue Oyster Cult and as the shows headliner national recording artist “The Spin Doctors” at 7:00pm.

Madison Barracks Polo Field and Parade grounds is a 21 acre park like setting with dynamic lakefront views of Lake Ontario. This site is superior in terms of available open areas and generous sized vendor areas with safe and secure parking areas available.

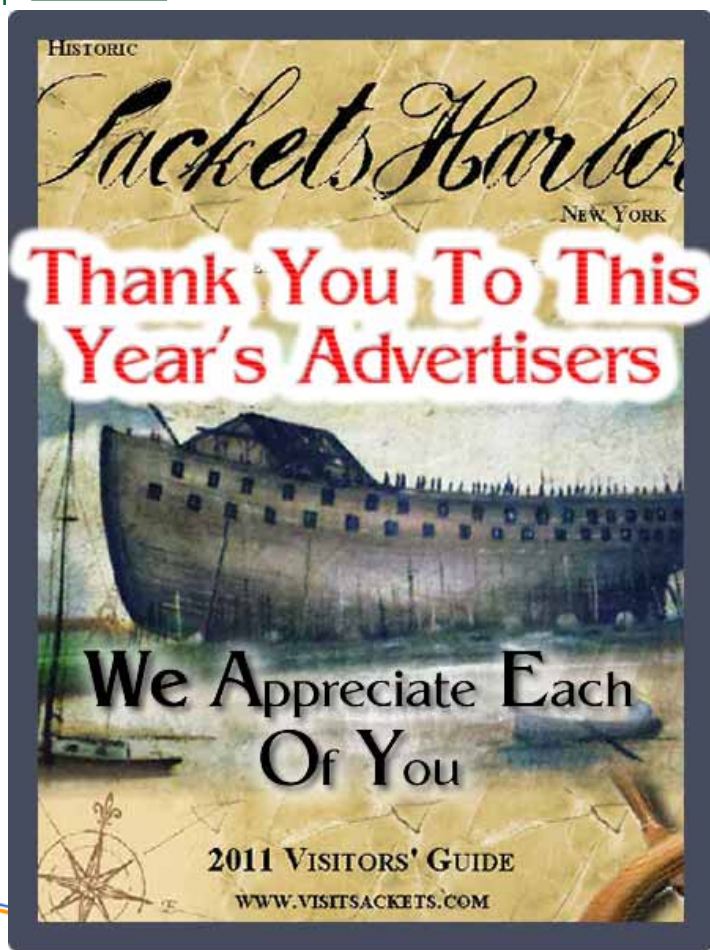

It Takes A Village To Plant A Tree

"Fairest of the Fair" by John Philipp Sousa

Arbor Day 2011 was celebrated in Sackets Harbor by planting two Pin Oaks, *Quercus palustris*, in remembrance of two beloved members of the community. At eight o'clock in the morning on Friday, April 29th, a dozen or more residents gathered across from the Fire Station for the first ceremony. Next to the restored pump house was a young oak in the prepared hole, waiting. After a short word from Kelly Reinhart, the Chairperson of the Village Tree Committee, the Mayor read the proclamation. The first tree is dedicated to the memory of Garrett Loomis, a brave Sackets Harbor firefighter who lost his life in April 2010 in the line of duty. His mother honored him by taking the first shovel of dirt and placing it in the hole. Then, his father, colleagues and friends took turns planting the tree.



At eight thirty, some of us moved over to the school and joined the family of Mary-Ellen Powers, some high school musicians and elementary students to plant the second tree. Again, Kelly and the Mayor proceeded with the formalities. The Superintendent also shared some thoughts. The tree represents the memory of Mary-Ellen who devoted her career to music education. The planting is located near the front of the gym where she would have looked out of her classroom window. Mr. Powers and his two daughters shoveled some dirt into the hole while the ensemble played. Community members, Mr. Buell, Mrs. Davis and Ms. Gaffney, along with students all took turns filing the hole of the second Pin Oak.

The now retired Botany Professor, Dave Haas, used to tell his students at every class: "Plants are people too." The Pin Oak is an angiosperm, the most evolved of all plants. They hold the same position in the plant world that humans do in the animal world. Like us, they can live to be 90-120 years old. In the fall, the foliage of the Pin Oak turns a spectacular bronze color. For those who believe in the cycle of life, you can believe that the spirit of Garrett and Mary-Ellen have a beautiful place in our village. As a young person, you can take a photo with the trees and grow with them in unison throughout the years. The gift of these two trees represents the value of our cherished loved ones. 2. Customers respond to value-added offers that are easy to calculate and recognize, such as "\$1 off adult museum admission" or "free dessert with purchase of dinner."
3. Consider changing coupon(s) throughout the year to learn which offers perform best.
